H1N1 Flu Update

H1N1 Free Flu Shots Available in San Bernardino County on Saturday, November 7, 2009

The 2009 H1N1 influenza vaccine will be distributed at three San Bernardino County Public Health Centers on Saturday, November 7TH. **The H1N1 Flu shot and the H1N1 FluMist vaccine will be available.** Due to the limited supplies, **only** the following priority groups will receive the H1N1 vaccine:

- Pregnant women,
- People who live with or care for infants younger than 6 months of age,
- Anyone from 6 months through 24 years of age, and
- Anyone from 25 through 64 years of age with certain chronic medical conditions or a weakened immune system.
- Health care and emergency medical personnel,

The following three Public Health Centers will offer the H1N1 flu shot and H1N1FluMist vaccine:

- The FluMist is licensed for healthy individuals two to 49 years of age.
- *Children nine years of age or younger will need two doses of H1N1 flu shot or FluMist vaccine (one month apart) for complete immunizations.
- Individuals 65 years of age and older are not in the priority groups and will not be eligible to receive the vaccine at this time.
- If you are not in any of the categories above, the vaccine may be available at a later time, please visit the Department of Public Health website or call the number below for up-to-date information.

The seasonal flu vaccine will not be available at any of clinics this Saturday.

H1N1 Free Flu Vaccination Available Weekdays in San Bernardino County
